## **Directors' Reports**

Superintendent Report: Superintendent Tulppo reported on the status of the Michigan Department of Education's Transportation Funding Committee study, on which he is a member. The committee issued its report to State Superintendent Dr. Michael Rice. GOISD local districts will most likely receive funding based on Quartiles 1 & 2, and funding will range from \$1,100 to \$2,000 per rider per square mile. Mr. Tulppo also shared that he is working with local superintendents in Ontonagon County to respond to the announced closure of the hospital and emergency room at Aspirus Ontonagon Hospital. He has been in communication with our state and federal elected officials.

**Financial Report:** Tammy Gibson completed the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter Medicaid Reimbursement report, previously done by Paulette Niemi. Patty Ollila has now taken over Watersmeet and Carole Robl is doing Ewen-Trout Creek. The report measures that we are spending at least as much on children with disabilities as we spending on children without before using IDEA (Special Ed Flow thru) funds. The required threshold has been met individually and ISD wide. A request for the board to approve RFP for a new software platform was made.

**General Education Report:** Eight local teachers came together for session 2 of the Classroom Library Makeover Project. They learned from Lynn at the Carnegie library best practices and the process of book selection. Emily Geiger from MiSTEM provided professional learning around the importance of including STEM and Career exploration books in classroom libraries. A donation of \$240 was received from the Wakefield/Bessemer Rotary. Crisis Response was requested at Ewen-Trout Creek as well as for the loss of one of our center based classroom students. The GOISD hosted a Computer Science script workshop for our local schools. We will be hosting a 3 day series Math and Literacy Summit launching March 1st.

Career and Technical Education Report: February is CTE month. Thank you to our Less-Than-Class-Size program sites, Big Valley Ford in Ewen and JSP Construction in Ontonagon. GOISD and GCC received grant funding to help support the CTE summer camps for grades 6-8. Transportation will be provided for all districts with the support of TRIO. As a region we are required to write a Regional Improvement Plan and goals to address our non-traditional program completion. Our CTE Food Systems and Natural Resources did a great job at their district and regional FFA competitions.
