

APPLICATION FOR MICHIGAN SUBSTITUTE TEACHER PERMIT

The Michigan Department of Education issues four types of permits to meet different school staffing needs when a properly certified and endorsed teacher is not available. Permits are granted to an employing school or school district. They are not portable between schools and are not held by an individual. However, if a Daily Substitute Permit is applied for by the GOISD, it will cover all schools within the ISD.
