Section 105 and 105c

Pupils enrolled under Section 105 of the State School Aid Act must be a resident of a district within the intermediate school district's boundaries. Pupils enrolled under Section 105c of the State School Aid Act must be a resident of a district within an intermediate school district contiguous to the boundaries of the education district's intermediate school district. In no case may districts charge tuition for pupils who are enrolled in the districts pursuant to Section 105c.

Signature verifies the district meets all requirements and complies with deadlines for applications as specified in Section 105 of the State School Aid Act of 1979.
